Chef Mohr started The Cooking School with a personal passion for teaching, and a mission to demystify cooking for the home cook. Mohr's goal is to bring joy back to the kitchen and families back to the dinner table.

Mohr recalls, "I knew there was a need and desire in the community for cooking classes, combined with my love for teaching, it seemed like an exciting idea." It turned out to be a perfect match! The Cooking School opened in 2007 with FREE Introductory demonstration classes. These classes were so popular that they continue today on a monthly basis. With an average of 10 different "hands-on" classes each month and no more than 12 participants per class, clients of The Cooking School have the opportunity to actually learn cooking methods. Through full Chef-led instruction, food sampling, and plenty of hands-on, participants have real time with real Chefs. The Cooking School also provides a unique venue for corporate team-building events, private group events, bridal showers, birthday parties and other special occasions.

In staying true to the mission of instruction, the Savor Hospitality website is a wealth of information including; complete class descriptions, an online calendar, a very simple ordering process, and class reviews from clients. For those interested, there is a FREE monthly newsletter that provides cooking tips, recipe inspirations and culinary news. Chef Mohr also plans to launch a daily (FREE) video blog this month with demonstrations and helpful food information.

Savor Hospitality was founded in 2002 on the premise that corporate catering had needs that were going unfulfilled by the typical "delivery" lunch options. Since then the company has grown to include a private event venue located at 815 West Chatham Street in Cary and The Cooking School, which opened in the summer of 2007 and has already seen over 300 local residents learn and improve their home cooking skills.

The vision of Savor Hospitality is to provide an extremely high level of cuisine and personalized service for all events, both on-site and off-site, including: corporate luncheons and team-building events, business meetings, weddings and rehearsal dinners, birthday and anniversary parties, and holiday events. The vision for The Cooking School is to teach "method" cooking over learning recipes so that clients re-enter their kitchens with confidence and joy in the knowledge that they can make great family meal times at home.
